We're glad that you and your child chose to participate in the Museum of Science and Technology's Expedition MOST February break camp! We have planned fun-filled days for your camper, so he or she should come home tired and happy.

You gave a \$50 deposit when you made your initial reservation, but that reservation isn't firm until we receive completed paperwork. You must complete a health form, permission form, emergency contact sheet, and confidential camper information sheet for each camper and return them to the MOST by Feb. 10, 2017.

Payment in full is due before the start of camp, on Feb. 20, 2017.

Here are some things you should know about Expedition MOST.

- Camp runs 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Feb. 20-24, 2017
- Drop-off time is 8:50 to 9 a.m. at the camp entrance (to the right of the MOST's Franklin Street main entrance by the large iron gates)
- Parents must sign in their campers every day
- Parents can park in the bus turnaround for drop-off, but please do not block access to the parking spaces on the sidewalk in front of the museum
- Make sure your camper is dressed for sitting, crawling, and playing outside, weather permitting
- Send a water bottle and indoor sweater or jacket, marked with the child's name, that can remain for the week
- Every camper will have a basket in the camp classroom to store gear
- Do not send your child with cell phones, tablets or other valuables; there is no place to lock them up
- Campers are provided a healthy mid-morning snack
- Campers must bring a lunch that doesn't need heating or refrigeration
- Pickup is at 3 p.m. via the same entrance as drop-off
- Parents must sign out their campers every day, and we will not release your child to anyone who is not listed on the child's contact sheet
- On the first day of camp, please be prepared to spend a few extra minutes checking your child's emergency paperwork
- If your child needs to leave camp early or miss a day, please notify us as early as possible so we can plan accordingly
