Launch Day Sequence

CHECK-IN YOUR ROCKET

Upon check-in at the REGISTRATION tent, your team will receive nametags, a scorecard, participation certificates, and your rocket motor, wadding, and "egg"stronaut.

ROCKET INSPECTION

Immediately following check-in, your rocket must be inspected. If the rocket fails inspection, please visit the TECH SUPPORT tent for assistance. If the rocket passes inspection, your rocket will be entered into the launch queue and you should wait to be called to mission control. You must provide your predicted apogee at this time.

3 WAIT TO BE CALLED TO MISSION CONTROL

When your team is called to MISSION CONTROL tent, your team must bring your rocket (with motor installed and wadding/egg inside) along with your scoresheet and clipboard. Please keep the nametags and participation certificates for team members.
