



Plant Seed Dispersal

Materials:

- Paper
- Cotton balls
- Pipe cleaners
- Example seeds
- Scissors
- Paper clips
- Glue
- Tape
- Optional: large fan
- Optional: organic materials such as grass
- Optional: Tub of water

Note: *Materials for this activity are flexible. Get creative!*

1. Design and build a seed that can travel away from its parent plant.
 - a. Some examples include attaching a cotton ball to a paper clip or attaching a paper clip to a ball of tape that has the sticky side on the outside.
2. Test your seed using different methods such as wind, water, or sticking to animals!
3. Experiment using different methods. Consider the benefits and effectiveness of different methods.
