

Plant Seed Dispersal

Materials:

- Paper
- Cotton balls
- Pipe cleaners
- Example seeds
- Scissors
- Paper clips
- Glue
- Tape
- Optional: large fan
- Optional: organic materials such as grass
- Optional: Tub of water

Note: Materials for this activity are flexible. Get creative!

- 1. Design and build a seed that can travel away from its parent plant.
 - a. Some examples include attaching a cotton ball to a paper clip or attaching a paper clip to a ball of tape that has the sticky side on the outside.
- 2. Test your seed using different methods such as wind, water, or sticking to animals!
- 3. Experiment using different methods. Consider the benefits and effectiveness of different methods.
