

Viewing Everyday Objects with a Microscope


Materials:

- Everyday objects


Note: The images provided can be used if a microscope is not available.

- 1. Using a microscope, observe daily objects under a microscope.
 - a. Note if an object may be too large, and how a scientist might take a sample.
 - b. Examples include dirt, grass, pencil or eraser shavings, or fingernail clippings.
- 2. Record observations and make comparisons. Note qualities like if a soft object appears rough, or vice versa.




Pencil and shavings

Eraser and shavings




